
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### 2iE: An Ambition for Africa

- Enhancing the quality of higher technological education in Africa


### CTI-EURACE label at 2IE: Impacts

- Regular increase in number of students : x6 between 2008 and 2012
- Development of student mobility from France to Burkina (Montpellier, INSA ROUEN, MINES ALBI...)
- 2IE member of the French Conférence des Grandes Ecoles and of the CONAHEC Consortium (North America)
- Development of double diplomas with French and Japanese engineering (underway) schools


### CTI-EURACE label at 2IE: Impacts

- Leadership in higher technological education: Transfer of 2iE experience in to countries (Gabon, Cameroon, Ivory Coast, Mali, etc..)
- Positive impact on pedagogical program (English and soft skills, etc)
- Positive impact on relations with private and public sectors with respect to the employment of our graduates
- Incentive to start a similar process with ABET

#### An growing international dimension:

- Students: 35 nationalities
- Professors: 18 nationalities / 4 continents
- Research: 15 partner universities / 7 countries / 4 continents

In 2011: 440 students graduated, 100 of which obtained a specialized Master's diploma


By 2013: 550 graduates will leave 2iE each year

## 2iE graduates work in Africa


2005 – 2010
