

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1	Parties	<p>The Institution of Engineers, Australia ABN 63 020 415 510 of 11 National Circuit, Barton ACT 2600 (Engineers Australia)</p> <p>Commission des Titres d'Ingénieur of 44 rue de Cambronne, 75 015 Paris, France (CTI)</p>
2	Date of MOU	<p>JANUARY 2019</p>
3	Effect of MOU	<p>The parties will negotiate in good faith and do everything necessary, or reasonably required by the other party, to give effect to this MOU.</p> <p>This MOU is not intended to be legally binding on the parties and does not give rise to legal rights or obligations.</p>
4	Objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The parties have agreed on the following academic thresholds for qualifications and competence as a professional engineer: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) An Australian engineering qualification accredited under the Washington Accord; (b) A Diplôme d'Ingénieur - equivalent to the Australian certification framework level AQF 9: Masters Degree - delivered by a French institution listed as accredited to do so in the annual inter-ministerial decree ("arrêté") at the time of graduation and delivered after the 1st January 1970 2. The parties will work collaboratively to strengthen the relationship between the organisations for mutual benefit and the engineers they serve. 3. CTI will do its best to promote Australian accredited engineering degrees. 4. Engineers Australia will consider the French Diplôme d'Ingénieur in accordance with the same processes as international Washington Accord qualifications. 5. Engineers Australia and CTI will nominate a representative to correspond with the other organisation in respect of this MOU. 6. Engineers Australia and CTI will do its best to promote, facilitate and extend professional and social links between the organisations.

5	Duration of MOU	This MOU will continue for a period of three (3) years.
7	Termination	Either party may terminate this MOU at any time by providing at least thirty (30) days' written notice to the other party.
8	Costs	Each party will bear its own costs in respect of the Project.
9	Counterparts	If this MOU is signed in counterparts then each counterpart is deemed an original and together they constitute one MOU.
